EXAMPLE OF ANGELIC ASSITANE PAST AND PRESENT!

Past: One powerful biblical illustration of **angelic assistance** is found in **Daniel 6:22**, when Daniel was thrown into the lions' den. Present: Imagine a person driving late at night on a quiet road. They are tired, distracted, and suddenly lose control of their vehicle—swerving towards a steep embankment. Just as disaster seems inevitable, they feel an unseen force steadying the car, guiding it back onto the road. Shaken but unharmed, they pull over, heart pounding, wondering how they avoided catastrophe.

Later, they recall that they had prayed earlier that day for protection and guidance, entrusting their journey to God. They realize that what seemed like an inexplicable save was **angelic intervention**, fulfilling the promise of **Psalm 91:11–12**, which says, "For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone."

This is just one way angels assist us in everyday life—whether in moments of danger, delivering divine messages, or orchestrating circumstances for our protection and provision. Sometimes, their work is unseen, but their presence is undeniable.

ANGELS AS MINISTERING SPIRITS!

Angels as Ministering Spirits

Hebrews 1:7, 14 describes angels as **flames of fire** and **ministering spirits** sent to serve those who inherit salvation. This means angels are **actively involved** in the lives of believers, carrying out divine assignments. Their ministry includes:

- Protection (Psalm 91:11–12)
